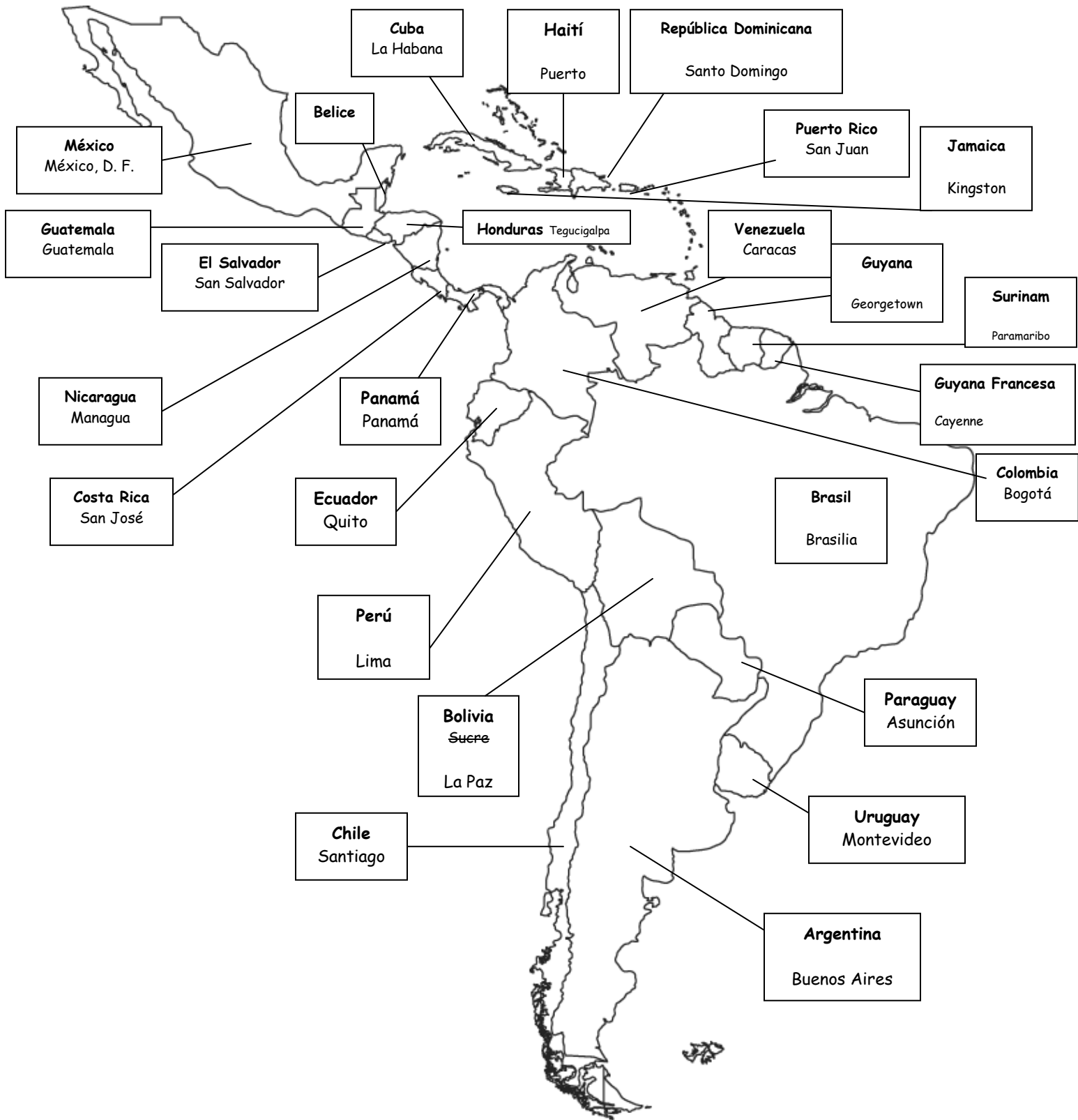


Research Project: Latin America and Spanish Speaking Country.

Student reads some information about the country, therefore the presentation is poor.</p>	<p>A quarter size poster with some black and white/color images of the country. Student reads scarce information about the country resulting in a very short and poor presentation.</p>
